## **Sr. Staff Reservoir Engineer**

Provide engineering leadership and direction to the Raton Asset within the Western Division in the areas of reservoir management, reserves management, and economic evaluations. Primary duties will be related to reservoir engineering in the Raton CBM field, including reservoir characterization, gas-in-place estimates, well performance analysis, well spacing determination, decline curve analysis, and discounted cash flow analysis of capital spending proposals including new drills and re-completions. Make recommendations regarding strategy, implementation and execution as it relates to development and exploitation opportunities; recommend well evaluation and testing programs for wells, and perform engineering analysis of the results. This job description reflects the minimum job duties for the lower level position.

A Bachelor's degree in Petroleum Engineering or related discipline is required with a minimum of 8 years experience in Petroleum Engineering. Prior reservoir engineering experience in the Rocky Mountain basins is beneficial. Strong analytical skills are required and reservoir simulation and field experience are a plus. Proficiency in Microsoft Word, Excel and Outlook as well as ARIES economic software is necessary. These requirements reflect the minimum requirements for the lower level position.
